GROOMING SPACE will be clearly defined for these events. Please cooperate with the following conditions as they will be strictly enforced by the Show Chairs and their respective committees. In order to afford all exhibitors ample grooming space, no soft-sided crates are allowed. All crates must be stacked, and no unentered dogs are allowed in the building. Play pens are not permitted to be used in place of crates.

No fairgrounds metal chairs permitted in the grooming areas.

PLANNING YOUR APPOINTMENT TIME: A dog's pupils start constricting again within 2-3 hours after drops so dogs with later ring times could be examined first thing in the morning. Pupil dilation does not affect the vision in dogs like it does humans because they do not accommodate (use the muscle in the iris to fine focus their vision). It can make some dogs a little light sensitive until the pupil can constrict some which is more of concern at outdoor shows on sunny days.



The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed.
